On September 4, 2008 the Environmental Impact Review Board (EIRB) received a referral from the Environmental Impact Screening Committee (EISC) titled: "Umiak Drilling, Completion, and Testing Project: 2008-2011." The project description was submitted to the EISC by MGM Energy Corporation.
